

# Prague Design Guide

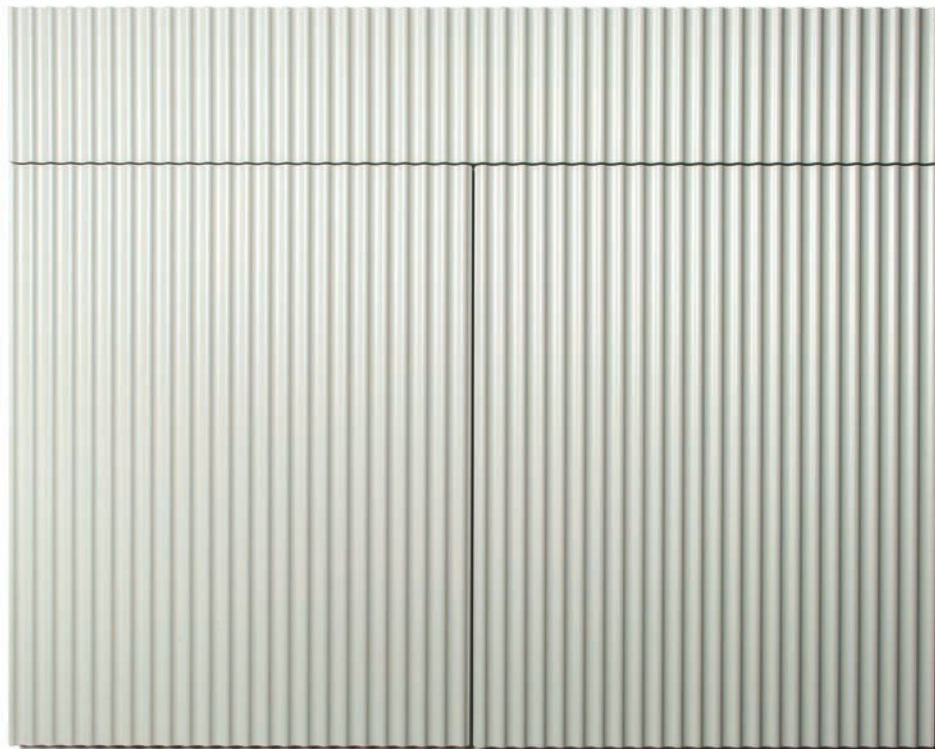
Prague is a fluted profile door that is a great option to provide visual interest for kitchen or bathroom cabinetry. The width of the groove is always 19mm as measured between the apex of the two flutes.

This design guide explains how to specify fluted doors, drawers and panels to achieve the look you want. Standard size doors and drawers will have flat sections at the outer edge that vary, depending on the width of the door.

## DOOR AND DRAWER SETS

With the standard 600, 800 and 900 door widths, the apex of the flute will always be in the middle of the door and there will be a flat section on either side. The width of the flat section will vary depending on the size of the door but will match the top panel.

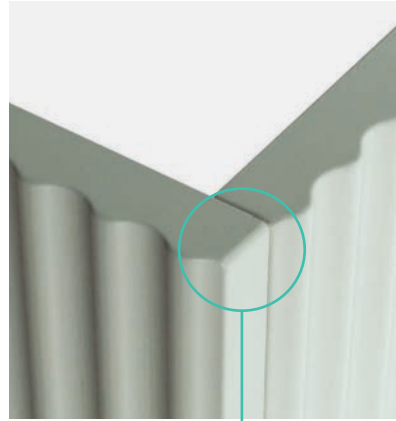
Door sets including a drawer must be ordered together and stipulate that the flutes need to align on both. Custom pricing applies. All door sets allow for a 2mm gap between doors.





### 90° CORNER OR USING DOORS WITH PRAGUE END PANEL

90° corner detail will have slight differences in width of flat sections at sides. One edge will always be 18mm reflecting the thickness of the adjacent panel.



18mm standard panel thickness.

Flat edge will vary depending on door width.



**Note:** the alternative to this, is to use the Prague door or panel on the main face and plain panels on the side(s) as pictured left.

### LIMITATIONS FOR PRAGUE PROFILE

- Boxed ends are not possible.
- Drawers are individual but should be ordered as a pack.
- Frame and Lattice doors are not available.
- Maximum hinge cup depth is 13mm.
- Handles – push-to-open catches or door-top finger pulls are the best option.
